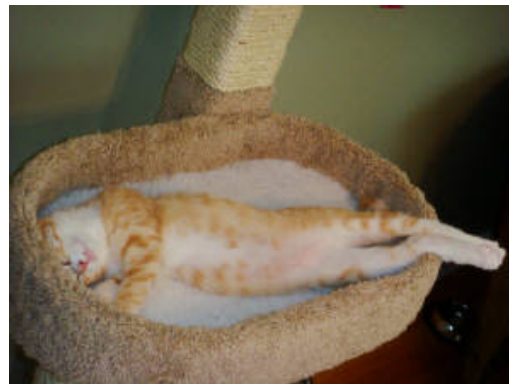


Kalina's Home
